

Policy statement: depositing theses on WRaP

To make your thesis publicly available on WRaP, a version must be created which complies with UK copyright law for publishing. The copy of your thesis which you submitted for assessment purposes can use educational exceptions to cover the use of copyrighted material. However making a digital copy publicly available (such as on WRaP) is considered a form of publication, requiring written permission to include or adapt other people's figures (the University of Cambridge has useful pages offering further [explanation](#) and [advice](#) on this topic). We therefore have to ask that the copyright holders for all figures within the thesis are clearly stated, and permissions for reuse have been sought, before we can make it publicly available. We do have a [guide](#) on how to create a 'WRaP-friendly' version of your thesis, or alternatively we can create a text-only version of the thesis.
